

# **January 15, 2008 - Antrim Township Board of Supervisors**

## **MINUTES OF THE ANTRIM TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS WORK-SESSION**

**Tuesday, January 15, 2008**

The Antrim Township Supervisors Work-session Meeting was called to order at 4:33 P.M. by Chairman Myers in the Antrim Township Municipal Building, 10655 Antrim Church Road. Present were Chairman Curtis Myers, Vice-Chairman Fred Young, III, James Byers (arrived at 4:45 P.M.), Sam Miller (arrived at 5:00 P.M.), Rick Baer, John Lisko, and Ben Thomas, Jr. Invited guests were Chad Dixon, Planner, Transportation Planning and Design; Mike Ross, President, Franklin County Area Development Corporation; Mike Christopher, Manager, Washington Township, PA. Visitors / citizens attending are listed separately.

During public comments, Bob Coladonato requested information regarding maintenance costs for proposed traffic signals along Molly Pitcher Highway South at a proposed entrance to tentatively approved Molly Pitcher Planned Residential Development. This will be researched for Mr. Coladonato.

Chairman Myers opened the meeting to discuss proposed Transportation Impact Fees. Manager Thomas presented a two year Antrim Township overview of discussions, requests for proposal received, and research. Mr. Dixon also presented an overview of Transportation Impact Fees and Studies in Pennsylvania as permitted in the Pa. Municipalities Planning Code. Information was also provided by Messrs. Ross and Christopher. All responded to questions offered by the Supervisors and citizens in attendance. Such a study and implementation takes approximately 18 months.

Supervisors Young and Baer were excused at 5:35 P.M. to attend a seminar at Shippensburg University.

The Supervisors requested this item be placed on the January 22, 2008 Regular Meeting agenda for further discussion.

The Work-session adjourned at 6:12 P.M. with no actions or resolutions presented.
