SPECIAL BUDGET MEETING

October 21, 2008 5:00 P.M.

The Antrim Township Board of Supervisors held a special budget meeting on Tuesday, October 21, 2008 in the Antrim Township Municipal Building, 10655 Antrim Church Road, with the following present: Chairman Curtis Myers, Vice Chairman Fred Young III, Rick Baer, Sam Miller and James Byers (arrived at 5:58 p.m.).

Visitors: Joel Wenger, Bob Coladonato and Greg Moats

Chairman Myers called the meeting to order.

Joel Wenger addressed the Board stating that he would prefer in lieu of cutting taxes, the Board consider placing some of those monies into the Budget for Land Preservation.

Discussion of the Budget:

Resolution # 487: A Baer/Miller motion passed with four votes (Byers was absent from the meeting) to send a letter to the Antrim Township Municipal Authority in reference to lift station generators, requesting that the Municipal Authority purchase eight new generators from the Authority repair and Improvement Fund at an estimated cost of \$200,000.00 and to relocate electric control panels associated with the generators at an estimated cost of \$105,000.00, also to be paid out of the Authority's Repair and Improvement Fund.

Resolution #488: A Miller/Baer motion passed with four votes (Byers was absent from the meeting) to obtain a safety deposit box at the First National Bank of Greencastle.

Byers arrived at this time.

Resolution #489: A Miller/Baer motion passed 4-1 (Byers voted nay) to hire Ami Myers as janitor for 8-10 hours a week at \$9.50 per hour.

Resolution #490: A Myers/Miller motion passed with unanimous vote to patch and repair Ridge Road and Maryland Line Road.

Resolution #491: A Byers/Miller motion passed with unanimous vote to send Paul Minnich and Curtis Myers to classes for Pennsylvania Emergency Management training November 5 and 6, 2008.
