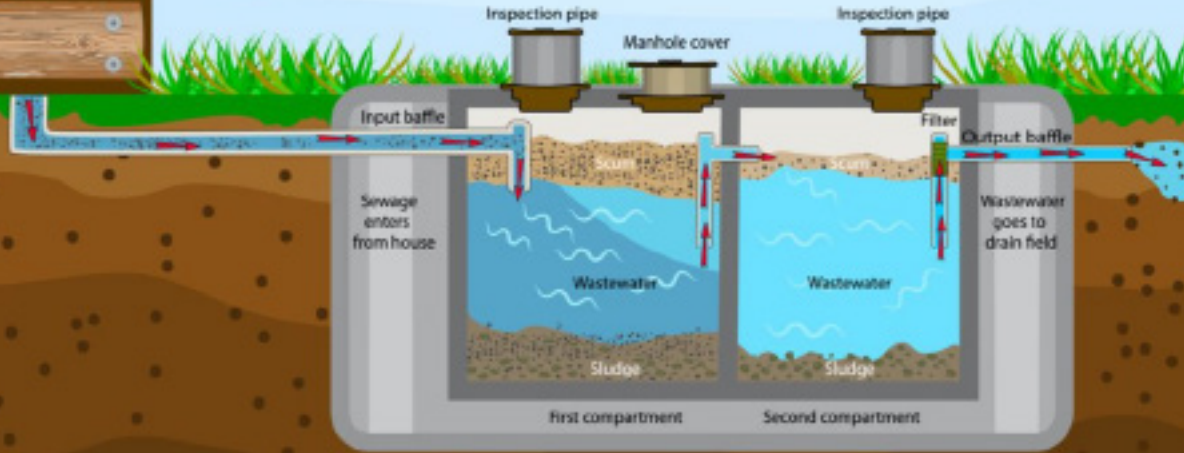


THE IMPORTANCE OF PUMPING



Water Quality

If your septic tank is not pumped out, the drains and other components of the septic system on your property can clog, releasing the water, along with pollutants. These pollutants can then enter the groundwater and flow into your local water system.



Clogs

While septic systems are designed to avoid clogs, they do still happen if the system isn't regularly pumped out. Solid materials inevitably end up in the tanks and pipes, and these will lead to clogs if the system is not cleaned out regularly.



Time & Money

Fixing clogs or bursts are among the most time-consuming and expensive septic services, so you want to do whatever you can to prevent the need for them.



Antrim Township Supervisors, as required by the Department of Environmental Protection and their approval of the Township's Act 537 Plan update, previously enacted said ordinance. The Sewage Management Ordinance promotes responsible stewardship of onlot septic systems in the township. The ordinance also is to ensure your onlot septic system is properly maintained and is not currently malfunctioning and creating a public health hazard. One of the primary and perhaps the most important factor of stewardship/maintenance of a septic system require that you have your septic tank pumped on a regular basis. As part of the Sewage Management. Ordinance, fines for non-compliance can be up to \$1000.00 per delinquent and/or non-compliant day. Thus, your prompt attention to this matter is critical.
